Don't miss the Free Speech Movement 50th Anniversary Reunion & Celebration, September 26-October 3, 2014!

Yes, it will be fifty years this October 1 when the FSM was born, and an incredible semester of political action and education got under way. If your participation in FSM meant—and continues to mean—as much to you as ours did to us—you will want to join us in Berkeley this fall for a weekend of reunion activities, followed by a week of campus events that look toward a better future, while honoring the past. We need to know NOW how many people to expect so that we can secure venues of the right size, make advance ticket reservations, arrange catering, etc. PLEASE RESPOND TO LET US KNOW IF YOU'RE COMING. Fill out the Registration Form. Pay now or later, but register now, please.

If you mail your check by July 1 you can take a \$10 Early Bird discount on the \$25 Registration fee. *If you want to reserve a ferry ticket for the Ai WeiWei art installation on Alcatraz, you must register and pay by 6/27.* Space is limited! (Payment is fully refundable until Sept.1, 50% refundable 9/1-9/15. After 9/15, refunds will only be given for documented medical emergencies.)

We need volunteers to do tasks now and during the reunion, as well as offers of housing from Bay area residents. Let us know your offers and your needs on the registration form. No FSM vet will be turned away for lack of funds. PLEASE ALSO MAKE A TAX-DEDUCTIBLE DONATION TO FUND SCHOLARSHIPS AND COSTS NOT COVERED BY THE REGISTRATION FEES.
